

Current Emory University Parking Permit Holders. Emory's new parking system includes new gate entry equipment as well as new permits. Below you will find pertinent information regarding this new parking gate system, parking gate entry, and billing.

How Will I Get Into My Parking Deck Before the Installation Period?

In the interim period before installation, you can use your old or new parking permit for parking deck entry. Please note the following:

- Your new permit **WILL NOT** grant you hands-free access with the current gating system.
- The barcode, located at the bottom of your new permit, should be swiped to enter the deck.
- You can use your old permit to grant you hands-free access.

How Will I Get Into My Parking Deck Once the Installation is Complete?

Your new permit will grant you hands-free access when the new technology is installed. Once the new technology has been installed, please use your new permit, as your old permit will no longer grant entry.

*Please note that date ranges are used because installation can be delayed due to factors outside of our control, such as weather.

Billing

Please note that your September usage and the associated charges will be billed in October. Moving forward, our billing cycle will follow the same cadence. Thus, your monthly bill will reflect charges for the previous month.

Smart Commute Permit Holders— Your permit has been loaded with 20 daily parks/swipes to be used for the period of 9/1/20 through 8/31/21. When all 20 swipes are used, should you continue to need to park on campus, you will be automatically charged \$6/day with a maximum monthly cap of \$56.

Surface Lot – If you park in a surface lot or parking space that is not gate access controlled, you will be charged \$6 per day with a maximum monthly cap of \$56. TPS monitors all surface and street parking throughout the business day (Monday-Friday, 7:00am-4:00pm). Smart Commute permit holders who park in a surface lot/street space will have a daily swipe deducted each day they park in a surface lot.
